

**PLYMOUTH COUNTY SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT
STATE COST SHARE PRIORITIES FOR JANUARY 1 to DECEMBER 31, 2025**

All Practices will be subject to terms of the maintenance agreement. Prices maybe adjusted at the Boards discretion.

- Terraces.
 - A. Tentative limit: Estimated project cost of \$35,000.00 per owner per calendar year. Total cost share dollars will not exceed \$17,500.00 per season.
 - B. First come first serve. Approval of applications will be made according to:
 - 1. Season of construction.
 - a. Summer
 - b. Fall
 - c. Spring
 - 2. Date of sign up.
 - C. Will use an estimate cost for terrace work, which will include the saving of topsoil, are:
 - Narrowbase terraces <14 – \$3.50 per foot
 - Narrowbase terraces ≥14 – \$3.50 per foot
 - Broad base terraces – \$4.00 per foot
 - Grassback terraces, on individual basis.
 - Seeding of practice - \$200.00 an acre
 - Water and Sediment Control Basin – \$3.50 a cubic yard
 - Allow an additional \$2.00 per foot for realignment jobs.
 - Intake with hookup - \$350.00 each
 - CMP Bands and labor –\$ 100.00 each
 - Anti-Seep Collar – \$100.00 each – Staff determine # needed.
 - CMP - \$11.00 a foot whatever footage is required for drainage in 24 hours.
 - Tile: up to 8” tile no more than \$4.00 per foot for tile, Over 8” tile no more than \$8.00
Per foot as per technician design, allow 50%
cost share not to exceed \$5,000.00 Total cost to take the tile to a stable outlet.
No cost share on grubbing
 - D. Terrace applications; new or Realignment requests will be considered by sign up date.
 - E. Cost share on broadbase terraces that are on slopes up to 8%. Will not cost share on any terraces that are on slopes over 18%
 - F. When State cost share funds are combined with other cost share sources, additional cost share cannot exceed a total of 75% cost share.
 - G. Cost share on earth work only. No cost share to be used toward tree grubbing and land preparation.
 - H. Contractor cut sheets, bill, and seeding sheets are required to be submitted to the District Office 7 days prior to the scheduled Commissioner meeting, in order to be listed on the scheduled meeting’s agenda.
 - I. Terraces cannot be removed without Commissioner prior approval. Terraces are under a 20 year maintenance agreement and may not be removed while under a maintenance agreement. Exception may be requested to the Commissioners prior to action being taken.

- Pasture/Hayland Planting (512) Cost share thru IFIP or REAP whichever has available funds. Cost share 50% to producers who turn crop ground into pasture or hayland planting. This is 50% cost share and a 5 year maintenance, Maximum of \$200.00 per acre. Requirement like windbreaks – must own at least 10 acres.
- Conservation Practice Removal
 - A. If land subject to a maintenance/performance agreement is converted to a nonagricultural use that does not require a permanent soil and water conservation practice which has been established with financial incentives, the practice shall not be removed until the owner refunds the appropriate amount of the payment received. Items will be reimbursed to the IDALS in the amount as determined by the Plymouth SWCD.
 - B. No cost share to remove terraces.
